Why Do I Have To Do A Saint Report

The reason you are asked to do a saint report is because taking a Saint on as your patron is an age old Catholic practice. The idea is that you get to learn about several different saints and pick one that you relate to and want to learn how to emulate their life. At your Confirmation Mass you will be confirmed in the name of that Saint, who will then constantly pray for you.

Include the Following

- Your First and Last Name
- Name of the Saint
- Saints Location and Date of Birth
- Why did you choose this saint?
- What were the kinds of struggles the saint had to endure?
- What miracles were performed by your saints?
- What do you like best about this saint?
- How can this saint help you on your faith journey?

Listing Your Source

- On a second page please list all sources (books, web sites, etc...) which you used in your research.
