


FOLLOWING JESUS AND CENTERED IN THE EUCHARIST, WE WORSHIP GOD AND SERVE OTHERS.


Dear Parish Members:

It is a wonderful grace to see how our lives make an impact on our world — whether that be the world of our families and friends, neighbors, co-workers or our parish.




Prayerfully Consider Being a Good Financial Steward

HOW MUCH SHOULD I GIVE?

The amount that is given is always a personal decision between you and God. Nevertheless it does call for a decision! Each person is called to contribute according to their gifts, means and ability. As always, charity involves a sacrifice, an “offering,” of myself for the good of another. Our charitable giving, then, is based on “Equal Sacrifice...Not Equal Gifts.” The chart below may be helpful in determining your decision for an appropriate weekly amount.

Since every talent, gift, grace and financial resource is a gift from God, our Sunday offering is a sign of giving to God the first fruits of His gifts to us. This is what the Sunday offering is all about: giving back to God! We are reminded of God’s generosity to us and we give back to Him through being generous to others, especially to the ministries of the Church. The above Suggested Weekly Offering is an indicator of the percentage of the first fruits of your household income that you can give back as a contribution to the parish. As Christ called the disciples, He also calls upon us now to reflect on the gifts He has given us and to return a portion of those gifts to Him. Do we give to God first from the gifts we are given as an act of faith? Or do we give from what we have “left over” or “extra?”

Each parishioner/household receives a Commitment Card. You will be asked to complete and return this card to the Parish Office or drop it in the Sunday offering collection basket. It is important that we receive a Commitment Card from every parishioner/household. Without this information, there is no way to properly budget and provide for the ministerial needs of the parish.


