## EASTER 2017


Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

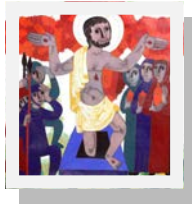

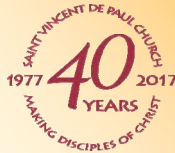

**A Journey for exploring the Catholic Faith**

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is a process whereby new members join the Catholic Church, designed specifically for the following:

1. For adults who have never been baptized and who want to inquire about the Catholic faith.
2. For adults who have been baptized into another Christian tradition (Lutheran, Methodist, Baptist, etc.) who want to inquire about the Catholic faith.
3. For baptized Catholic adults who have not completed the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation and need more faith formation.

If you fit into any of these categories or have a friend or relative who does, please contact **Elsa Lusk at the parish office: 714-842-3000 x12 or send an email at [rcia@svdphb.org](mailto:rcia@svdphb.org)**. The RCIA process of becoming Catholic will meet on **Wednesday, April 19 from 7 PM to 8 PM in Meeting Room 8**. You can enter at any time during the year. All those interested in becoming Catholic must experience a full year in our church community; therefore, it is good to enter the journey as soon as possible.

If you are a baptized Catholic and you **only** need the Sacrament of Confirmation, you may join the Adult Confirmation process which meets on Sunday mornings beginning in the Fall. For more information contact Elsa Lusk at the number above.

## PASCUA 2017


Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

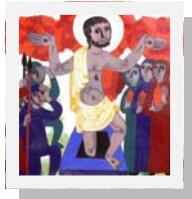

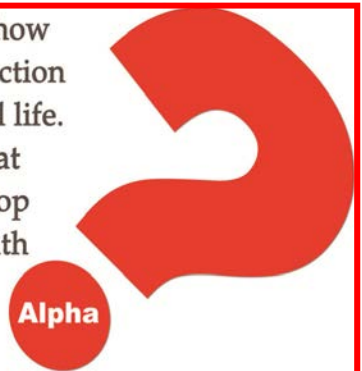

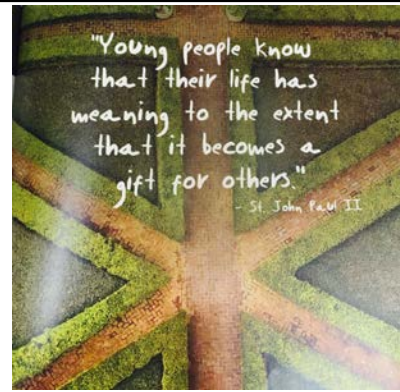
