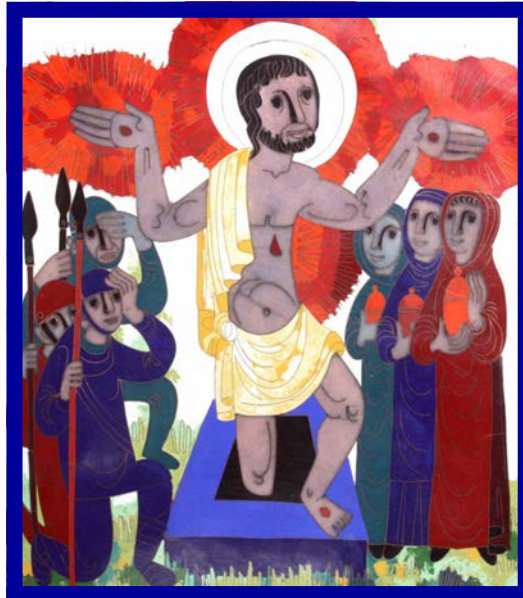

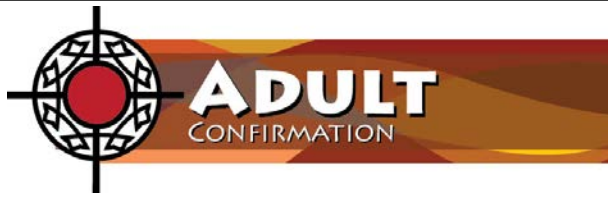

**VI DOMINGO DE PASCUA AÑO A  
PRIMERA LECTURA HECHOS 8, 5-8. 14-17  
SEGUNDA LECTURA 1ª DE PEDRO 3, 15-18  
EVANGELIO JUAN 14, 15-21**

*“Yo rogaré al Padre y les dará otro Protector que permanecerá siempre en ustedes, por eso no quedarán huérfanos”*

Queridos hermanos, la semana pasada Jesús entristeció a sus discípulos cuando les dijo que no se turbara su corazón porque tenía que regresar a la casa del Padre pero luego los alegró diciéndoles que se iba a prepararles una mansión. En el evangelio de hoy estamos todavía dentro de la cena de despedida, Jesús quiere que se queden los discípulos bien seguros que no se quedaran solos para continuar en el camino, en la verdad y en la vida, es decir permanecer en Cristo.

Así como Jesús se fue a preparar un lugar para nosotros hoy Felipe esta preparando un lugar en el corazón de los samaritanos para aceptar a Jesús a través de las señales que obraba. Estas son las mismas señales que Jesús obró en su vida pública. La primera lectura dice que frente a la predicación de Felipe muchos espíritus inmundos eran expulsados de las personas, ese espacio le pertenecía a Dios y los espíritus inmundos lo habían ocupado. Al escuchar los apóstoles en Jerusalén (la Iglesia Madre) que los samaritanos habían acogido la predicación de Felipe envían a Pedro y a Juan para que al rezar por ellos descenderá el Espíritu Santo.

Este sexto domingo de Pascua es como un pequeño adviento, que nos invita a preparar un lugar en nuestra vida al don que Jesús nos quiere dar como fruto de su Resurrección, el Don del Espíritu Santo. ¿Cómo podemos prepararnos? Pues empezando por acoger la palabra de Dios en nuestra vida, dejar que la predicación expulse a los espíritus inmundos que han tomado posesión de lo que le pertenece solo a Dios. Este regalo por excelencia, es otro defensor, otro que abogara por nosotros frente al Padre.

Que consolador es hermanos escuchar de los labios de Jesús que no nos deja huérfanos, nos enviara el Espíritu de Verdad, espíritu que es el mismo amor del Padre y del hijo ya que procede de ambos, pero aunque proceda de es una persona diferente a ellos. Es nada más ni nada menos que la tercera Persona de la Santísima Trinidad la que habitara dentro de nosotros.

¡Animo! sabemos que estamos en Cristo que es el camino, la verdad y la vida porque estamos dentro de la Iglesia que nos alimenta con la Palabra de Dios, con el Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo que son verdadero alimento. 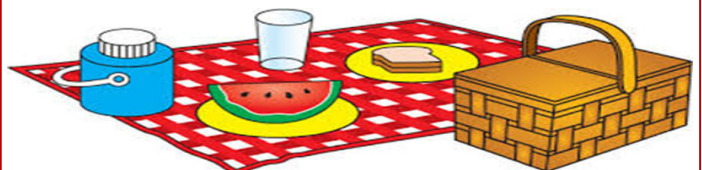
