Construction 2017 UPDATE

Thanks to the parish members who have contributed
 to the CONSTRUCTION 2017 fund! We have raised
 just over \$170,000 and still hope to receive \$30,000 in
 order to reach our \$200,000 goal!

As you have noticed, the buildings are taking shape
 and everything should be completed in early
 December!

The project will provide an enlarged and accessible
 Reception desk and Lobby area, two new Staff
 Offices, a Staff Lounge, a Workroom as well as an
 Accessible Restroom and a Meeting Room. We will
 also finally have Air Conditioning and Heating for the
 Parish Hall!

In addition to our original plans, we will also enhance
 our Parish Hall with new vinyl flooring, acoustical
 panels on the walls, and new paint. The Kitchen will
 also be improved with new tile flooring, cabinets and
 countertop, a new Range/Stove and Stock Pot as well
 as stainless wall finishing behind the stove, and
 painting. For all of this we hope to exceed our
 \$200,000 goal!

All of this will enhance our parish property and be
 enjoyed by parish members for years to come.

"A mi hijo lo respetaran" pero los trabajadores, al ver al hijo se dijeron: este es el heredero.

Lo matamos y así nos quedamos con su herencia>>

Queridos hermanos, hace algunas semanas, Jesús nos enseñaba como poder ayudar a los demás llegar a la salvación: <<Si tu hermano peca contra ti, ve corrígelo en privado, si te escucha habrás salvado a tu hermano>> y también: <<perdona a tu hermano, no siete veces sino siete veces setenta>> ¿lo recuerdan? Las dos últimas semanas nos invitaba a trabajar en su viña; la primera como jornaleros y la segunda como hijos. ¿Porque Jesús nos ha dado todas estas parábolas?

Como siempre les he dicho Jesús no hace nada por casualidad, todo tiene un sentido. En las primeras parábolas lo que pretendía era que viéramos al otro como hermano, exactamente como él nos mira. Las dos últimas nos ve como como discípulos que invita a trabajar en su viña (en la parábola de los jornaleros) y en la parábola de la semana pasada nos ve como hijos cuando se el Padre manda a sus dos hijos a trabajar en su viña. Nos hace pasar de simple jornaleros a hijos.

Sobre esta parábola hay muchas interpretaciones una por ejemplo es que Dios al rechazar a los que les había confiado la viña estaba rechazando a Israel. La verdad es que la parábola de hoy tiene un sentido más personal que nacional. Lo que está diciendo Jesús es que los viñadores homicidas no es el pueblo de Israel en general sino los líderes religiosos que rechazan al enviado de Dios. Lo que esta Dios rechazando no es al pueblo de Israel sino a sus dirigentes, que son rechazados y reemplazados. Lo mismo ara Jesús nunca rechazara a su Iglesia que la compro al precio de su sangre sino a los malos dirigentes, que se apropian de lo que le pertenece a Dios.

Jesús nos invita a convertimos, cambiar actitud hacia lo que es de Dios que a lo mejor sin querer nos hemos apropiado. Debemos estar alertas a los mensajeros que Dios no envía; como dice San Pablo: <<¿qué es tuyo, que no te fue dado?>> el tema central es hermanos nuestra propia responsabilidad con lo concerniente a nuestra Salvación, cada uno de nosotros tiene la posibilidad de salvarse, si lo quiere claro. En otro pasaje Jesús nos aclara que para salvarse no basta reconocerse hijos de Abraham, no sirve apelar a los privilegios del pasado. La salvación es una cosa personal que la decidimos en nuestras obras y actitudes frente a Dios y frente al anuncio de Cristo.

La buena noticia hermanos es que Jesús nunca rechazara a su esposa la Iglesia, porque la esposo en la cruz y la embelleció con su resurrección. Aquí la cuestión es cual tipo de arrendatario somos. **A)** ¿De los que se apoderan de lo que le pertenece a Dios y le quitamos su gloria? o **B)** de los que saben que lo que tienen les fue prestado y en cualquier momento vendrá el dueño de la viña a pedir cuentas y estamos prontos a regresar los frutos que no son nuestros.
