## Construction 2017 Special Collection

As is usually true, construction costs are higher than expected! For example, we have an additional \$41,000 expenditure for a revised plan to increase the air capacity of the air and heat for the Parish Hall. Of course we will finally enjoy Air Conditioning and Heating in the Hall! But it cost a lot!

**To help us reach and even exceed our goal, please plan to contribute to this Special Collection next weekend! There will be envelopes available in the pews next weekend. Please make your usual contribution for your parish Sunday Offering for our operating costs and be prepared to make another contribution for this Special Collection!**

The buildings are taking shape and the project will provide an enlarged and accessible Lobby area, two new Staff Offices, a Staff Lounge, a Workroom as well as an Accessible Restroom and a Meeting Room. We will also enhance our Parish Hall with new vinyl flooring, acoustical panels on the walls, and paint. The Kitchen will be improved with new tile flooring, cabinets and countertop, a new Range/Stove and Stock Pot as well as stainless wall finishing behind the stove, and painting. For all of this we hope to exceed our \$200,000 goal! This would be a great time to make a Year-End tax deductible contribution to the Church!

PRIMERA LECTURA SABIDURÍA 6,  
SEGUNDA LECTURA 1A TESALONICENSES 4, 13-18  
EVANGELIO MATEO 25, 1-13**

*“A media noche se oyó un grito: << ¡viene el novio, salgan a su encuentro! >> Todas las vírgenes, se despertaron y prepararon sus lámparas”*

Queridos hermanos, el tiempo ordinario concluirá en dos semanas y vemos como las lecturas dominicales nos ayudan a prepararnos espiritualmente a la inminente segunda venida de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo. En evangelio de hoy Jesús nos dice de estar despiertos porque en la hora menos esperada llegara el novio por la esposa para celebrar las bodas que hace unos domingos el rey le preparo a su hijo.

La parábola de las vírgenes se encuentra solo en Mateo, porque recuérdense que Mateo escribía a judíos convertidos al cristianismo y donde quiera que se encontrasen ciertas tradiciones comprendían muy bien. Una de estas tradiciones era la forma de celebrar en todo su conjunto las bodas que muchos de los pueblos circundantes celebraban de la misma forma. Toda boda judía tenía una preparación antes, durante y después.

Lo que Jesús cuenta en la parábola de hoy se refiere a lo que sucedía antes del matrimonio, se conocía como acuerdo pre-nupcial. El novio tenía que ir a la casa del Padre, a pedir la mano de la novia y el padre ponía un precio alto como dote no porque quería sacar ventaja de la ocasión sino para que el novio se diera cuenta cuanto amaba y valía su hija para él. El llegar a un acuerdo podía tomarse mucho tiempo y si la hija era de un hombre importante se tomaba aún más tiempo que podían ser talvez horas. *(se ve que esta era hija de un hombre muy importante).*

Jesús tomando ocasión de esta primera parte del Matrimonio, invita a sus auditores y por la tanto también a todos nosotros a estar preparados porque sin duda alguna hemos sido invitados a las bodas del cordero, y no sabemos cuándo el contrato entre el Padre y el Novio está por cerrarse.

Mientras tanto, ¿Que nos toca hacer? Sin duda estar despiertos y mirando constantemente la lámpara para que no se le acabe el aceite. La lámpara es nuestra vida, nuestro comportamiento como cristianos. El aceite es la oración, la hospitalidad, las obras de misericordia, el amor a Dios y al prójimo. Todo esto es lo que nos mantiene despiertos esperando al novio que está por llegar.

¡Animo! la buena noticia es que el novio viene, está tocando tu puerta, ¿no lo escuchas? Sino lo escuchas es porque estas dormido y sin aceite, la iglesia te dice que te levantes vallas a comprar el aceite para que el novio que es Jesús Nuestro Señor te encuentre despierto.
