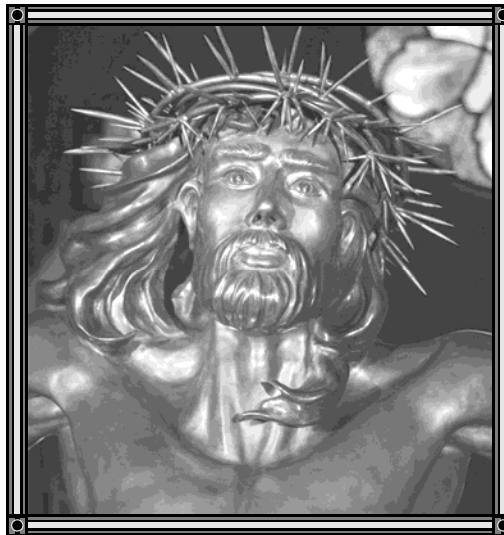

IV DOMINGO DE CUARESMA AÑO B
PRIMERA LECTURA II CRÓNICAS 36, 14-16. 19-23
SEGUNDA LECTURA EFESIOS 2, 4-10
EVANGELIO JUAN 3, 14-21

“Y como Moisés elevó la serpiente en el desierto, así tiene que ser elevado el hijo del hombre”

Queridos hermanos, El evangelio de este domingo IV de Cuaresma, se encuentra dentro del dialogo entre Jesús y Nicodemo un maestro de la ley. Jesús le recuerda que para obtener la vida eterna no basta cumplir la ley sino reconocer a Jesús como el enviado del Padre, el Mesías (que no tuvieron problema Moisés y Elías de reconocer a Jesús como el Mesías el día de la transfiguración.

La semana pasada Jesús expulso a los mercaderes del templo, porque habían hecho de la casa de su Padre una cueva de ladrones, pues hoy la primera lectura nos viene a confirmar que lo que Jesús hizo también su Padre lo había hecho en el pasado con el pueblo de Israel. *“Del mismo modo, todos los jefes de los sacerdotes y el pueblo multiplicaron sus infidelidades, según todas las costumbres abominables de las gentes, y mancharon la Casa de Yahveh, que él se había consagrado en Jerusalén”* (2 Crónicas 36, 14). Si hemos permitido que Jesús limpiara nuestro corazón, la semana pasada, que quitara nuestra ceguera espiritual es para poder reconocerlo como el enviado del Padre para salvarnos de nuestros pecados. La base para esto se encuentra en *Juan 3, 16* uno de los versículos más famosos de las Escrituras *“Porque tanto amo Dios al mundo, que dio a su Hijo unigénito, para que todo el que crea en él no perezca, sino que tenga vida eterna”*.

Con la exclamación: *“Y como Moisés elevó la serpiente en el desierto, así tiene que ser elevado el hijo del hombre”* Juan nos invita a mirar hacia arriba, a mirar al crucificado, el que por amor murió por nosotros, para que obtengamos la vida eterna, para que nuestros pecados, nuestras faltas no nos alejen de su misericordia, de hecho, el cuarto domingo de Cuaresma es llamado el Domingo de la Alegría porque no hay pecado que sea más grande que el amor de Dios. Dios nos ama y quiere que hagamos una cosa sola que, *“elevemos nuestros ojos al crucificado”* al que murió por nosotros y que volverá a morir por nosotros entro de tres semanas.

Miremos al que por amor murió por nosotros, para que obtengamos la vida eterna. La vida eterna no es solo para gozarla en el otro mundo, es para utilizarla aquí en la tierra. *¿Para que nos sirve la vida eterna en la tierra?* Pues para poder hacer lo que nos dice San Pablo en el versículo 10 de la segunda lectura: *“En efecto, hechura suya somos: creados en Cristo Jesús, en orden a las buenas obras que de antemano dispuso Dios que practicaríamos”*.

Jesús siempre decía que él vino no hacer su voluntad, sino hacer la voluntad de aquel que lo envió. Él que lo envió fue Dios, Dios de antemano había predispuesto que Jesús obrara buenas obras (*las buenas obras fueron los milagros*) pero la obra por excelencia fue la Resurrección. Tú y yo también hemos sido creados a imagen de Cristo para cumplir las obras que Dios de antemano quiso que practicaríamos. Mi pregunta es: *¿Sabes cuales son las obras que debes practicar?, ¿no lo sabes?* pues muy simple, levanta los ojos y mira al crucificado, mira al que murió por tus pecados, al que murió por amor a ti y él te dirá cuales son. Te recuerdo dos obras: **1) perdona al que te ofenda y 2) reza por tus enemigos.**

Cristo quiso morir en la cruz para decirnos que el entro libremente a un lugar mas maldito que ha existido (*en su tiempo era morir crucificado*) hoy podría ser la inyección letal. Entró allí para decirnos que no hay pecado que él no perdone porque no hay lugar donde él no haya estado. *¿Entiendes?* Si Jesús dijo: *«como Moisés elevó la serpiente en lo alto»*, es para decir que así debe ser elevado él en la cruz porque lo que nos atrae hacia él son nuestros pecados que nos hacen malditos, como él era maldito colgado en la cruz.

¡Animo, convirtámonos!

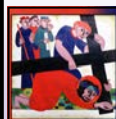
