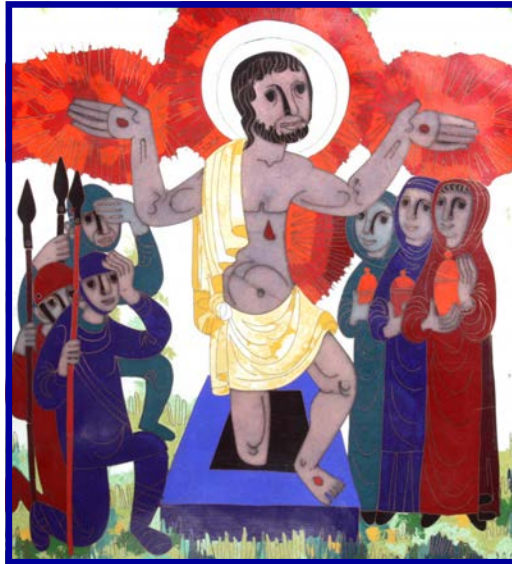

EVANGELIO LUCAS 24, 35-48

“Miren mis manos y mis pies, soy yo. Tóquenme”

Queridos hermanos el día de la Resurrección Jesús no permitió que lo tocara María Magdalena ni sus apóstoles, solo les mostro sus llagas. La semana pasada Domingo de la Divina Misericordia, permitió que un apóstol lo tocara y este fue Tomas, le permitió introducir sus dedos en sus llagas y la mano entera en la herida de su costado, para que con sus llagas fuera curada su doble incredulidad. Hoy Cristo da un paso a delante en su instrucción pascual a sus apóstoles y discípulos.

Recuerden que durante su ministerio público les enseñaba y los instruía en muchas cosas, ahora después de su resurrección en estos últimos 50 días antes de su Asunción los ilumina, les abre la mente para que no quede más duda en ellos que él es el Señor. Este tercer Domingo de Pascua, al invitar al resto de los apóstoles a que lo toquen, esta invitando a todos nosotros a tocarlo: <<Miren mis manos y mis pies, soy yo. Tóquenme y fjense bien que un espíritu no tiene carne, no huesos como ustedes ven que yo tengo>> (Mt 24, 39)

¿Porque creen que nos invita a tocarlo? dos motivos:

el primero: *para sanar nuestras heridas,* y **el segundo** *para anunciar su amor a los demás,* esto solo se puede hacer una vez que hemos experimentado en nuestra propia carne su perdón y hemos sido convencidos en nuestro interior que es el Señor. <<Luego debe proclamarse en su nombre el arrepentimiento y el perdón de los pecados, comenzando por Jerusalén y yendo después a todas las naciones, llamándolas a la conversión>> (Mt, 24, 47)

La clave de este evangelio es lo que subrayo Jesús en el versículo 48: <<Ustedes son testigos de todo esto>> ¿de que cosas somos testigos para poder anunciar a nuestro prójimo y al mundo que Jesús ha resucitado? Pues que nos ha perdonado nuestros pecados, que no nos juzga, y sobre todo que nuestras heridas fueron curadas, que el mal que nos han hecho ya no nos hace sufrir. Que la muerte ha sido vencida en la resurrección de Jesucristo.

Me preguntaras: ¿Cómo puedo saber que esto es verdad? Muy sencillo, porque en algún momento de tu vida lo has experimentado, porque fue posible abrirte a los demás, porque perdonaste una ofensa y sobre todo porque vives en la alegría. Una alegría que nada ni nadie te la puede quitar.
