EVANGELIO MARCOS 16, 15-20

“Después de hablarles, el Señor Jesús fue llevado al cielo y se sentó a la derecha de Dios”

Queridos hermanos, hemos llegado al final de los días de Jesús en la tierra. Con esta fiesta Jesús concluyó su última etapa de la formación de sus discípulos, a esta etapa le llamamos la Catequesis mistagógica, la iluminación en el intelecto de los apóstoles y discípulos. Si bien recuerdan en estos días pascuales Jesús nos mostró sus llagas como signo del perdón de nuestros pecados, nos llamó ovejas, sarmientos y la semana pasada nos llamó amigos.

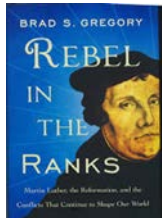

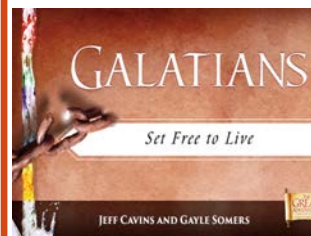
