Posture Change during the Mass

To show proper reverence and awe for the Most Holy Eucharist there will be a change for posture in the Mass in the Diocese of Orange.

In order to foster a sense of awe and gratitude for the gift of the Eucharist, Bishop Vann has asked that we make a change in our posture during the latter part of the Eucharistic Prayer. Currently we stand from the Great Amen until after receiving Holy Communion.

The faithful are now asked to:

- kneel after the Lamb of God (Agnus Dei) in veneration of the Eucharist
- remain kneeling until the people in your pew stand to join the Communion Procession.

There are occasions when this kneeling posture will not be possible, such as when an individual is prevented by ill health, or for reasons of lack of space, or the large number of people present. This change in posture will ideally help us become more conscious and intentional about our sense of reverence and awe of the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist: Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity.

Our gestures and postures help to bring about a sense of unity among all worshippers. Let all that we do help us enter into our prayer and worship to bring about our sanctification and that of our world.

Para mostrar la debida reverencia y respeto por la Santísima Eucaristía habrá un cambio de postura en la Misa de la Diócesis de Orange.

Con el fin de ayudar a fomentar un sentido de respeto y gratitud por el don de la Eucaristía, el Obispo Vann ha pedido que cambiemos nuestra postura durante la última parte de la Plegaria Eucarística. Actualmente nos ponemos de pie desde el Gran Amén y hasta después de recibir la Sagrada Comunión.

Ahora, el Obispo Vann, les pide a los fieles que:

- se arrodillen después del Cordero de Dios (Agnus Dei) en veneración de la Eucaristía
- permanezcan de rodillas hasta que las personas de su banca se unan a la Procesión de Comunión.

Hay ocasiones en que esta postura no será posible, como cuando una persona se ve impedida por alguna enfermedad, o cuando hay de falta de espacio, o que hay una gran cantidad de personas presentes. What is RCIA and who is it for?

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is a process whereby new members join the Catholic Church, designed specifically for the following:

- For adults who have never been baptized and who want to inquire about the Catholic faith.
- For adults who have been baptized in another Christian tradition (Lutheran, Methodist, Baptist, etc.) who want to inquire about the Catholic faith.
- For baptized Catholic adults who have not completed the Sacraments of First Holy Communion and Confirmation and need more faith formation.

If you fit into any of these categories or have a friend or relative who does, please contact **Mary Kay Lamarre at the Parish Office: (714) 842-3000 x123 or send an email at rcia@svdphb.org** The RCIA process of becoming Catholic meets on **Wednesday nights from 7 PM to 8 PM in Meeting Room E**. You can enter at any time during the year. All those interested in becoming Catholic must experience a full year in our church community; therefore, it is good to enter the journey as soon as possible.

If you are a baptized Catholic and you **only** need the Sacrament of Confirmation, you may join the Adult Confirmation process which meets Sunday mornings beginning November 11, 2018 at 11 AM in Room E.
