IRA COTRIBUTIONS

If you (or others you know) are over 70 1/2 years old, and if you have an IRA account and are required to take an annual RMD (Required Minimum Distribution), here's a way to take some or all of the RMD tax free.

This is especially beneficial if the new \$24,000 Standard Deduction prevents you from taking a deduction on Schedule A for charitable donations.

You can donate to any qualified Charity, such as your Church, PSA, etc. using some or all of your RMD by using a form called QCD (Qualified Charitable Distribution). These funds will be taken from your IRA Income Tax free. Check this out with your financial advisor.
