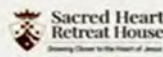

**Film: St Helena - The First Pilgrim**  
**Suggested Viewing Ages: 13 years +**  
**Run Time: 1 hour**

### Summary:

This is a wonderful documentary film telling the story of St. Helena and how, through her efforts, the sacred places in the Holy Land were identified and preserved. St. Helena was the mother of the Roman Emperor, Constantine the Great, the emperor who converted and ended Rome's Christian persecutions. In the year 326, Helena made the first religious pilgrimage to the places found in the Gospels.

This was almost 300 years after Christ's death. By then, Jerusalem and surrounding area had been mostly forgotten. She diligently investigated the places identified in the Gospels. She was able to find and identify the many sacred places. She then had churches built on these sites; churches which we still have today. If it was not for her efforts in those early years, we would not have the Holy Land as we now know it. Helena was the one who found the True Cross on which Jesus was crucified.

### Summary:

The Song of Bernadette is a 1943 film based on the novel of the same name. It tells the story of St. Bernadette and the apparitions of our Blessed Mother at Lourdes, France in the year 1858. Bernadette Soubirous was from a very poor family in a small village in the mountains of southern France. She had difficulty learning, could not read or write, and suffered from asthma.

Our Lady appeared to Bernadette starting February 25, 1858. This movie tells of Bernadette's life, starting with the apparitions until her death. It also gives us accounts of several early miracles worked by the waters of Lourdes during these initial apparitions.
